The competitors with 8 best scores in the qualifying rounds in the different age groups will be qualified to the final.

In the case of 8 or less competitors in a category in qualifying round, all of them will be qualified to the finals. No competitor will go through to the final with a total score of zero from the qualifications.

The gymnasts will start finals with a score of zero.

ACCREDITATION	Delegation accreditation will take place upon arrival. For accreditation, Heads of the Delegations are required to bring the following documents: • Passports (or National ID Card) of all members of the delegation • Proof of total payments • Proof of medical insurances • European health pass for all members of the delegation All financial obligations must be fulfilled before arrival or during the accreditation. Accreditation cards will not be delivered unless all financial and insurance obligations have been met. Accreditation card is personal for each of the delegation members. All participants and officials are required at all times to wear their Accreditation Cards
JUDGES AND JURIES	The participating Delegations can present judges per discipline with FIG judges brevet as follow: TRA/TUM: 1 or 2 gymnasts: 0 or 1 judge TRA/TUM: 3 gymnasts and more: 1 or 2 judges. Note: Transport, accommodation and meals of the judges of each delegation are of the respective delegation's responsibility.
