



Quattro Gymnastics can offer the club the opportunity to run its own stand at a competitive event or internal sale.

Here is the main information on how to manage the stand, how to set it up and the benefits for the club:

Commission and payment management

- Commission of 15% of sales excluding VAT for the club

In general, competition stands bring in between €1,500 and €3,000 excluding VAT, i.e. a commission of €225 to €450 for the club.

- Payment by credit card via a payment terminal supplied by Quattro or in cash (see user guide).
- The commission is first taken from the cash collected by the club and the remainder is then paid by Quattro by bank transfer, if necessary.

Equipment provided by Quattro

- A card payment terminal
- A tablet for recording orders
- A dedicated stock of merchandise
- A tablecloth to decorate the stand
- A stand user guide
- All the signage needed for the stand (size guides, price guides, etc.)

Equipment to be supplied by the club

- Display racks for leotards (all sent on hangers)
- Tables and chairs if required
- Fitting room or changing rooms can be used
- Provide a cash float

Logistics management

Stock sent 1 week before the stand by Quattro (French headquarters) to the address given by the club

- Received and checked by the club
- Returned using pre-paid packing slips sent by Quattro in the week following the sale

- Instagram and Facebook post + A3 poster sent by Quattro

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
