01. GENERAL INFORMATION

This tournament will be organized in Antibes, France from 3rd to 5th October 2025, at the same time as the, **WORLD CUP in Trampoline and Tumbling** *details on FIG Website – Event's ID 17872*

Azur Acro Cup is open to federations and clubs for SENIOR level units with open ages (at least 13 years old)

02. PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE

Vertical clearance above the performance area in Training Hall (Warm up): 12m

04. COMPOSITION OF DELEGATIONS

Each delegation may include:

1 Head of Delegation

1 Team Manager

Unlimited number of Acrobatics units and coaches

2 medical staff

2 judges (**1 judge minimum ***)

If no judge is present, a financial penalty will be applied = **500 € penalty fee*

05. CATEGORIES - COMPETITION FORMAT – ENTRY FEES

This competition will be running to **SENIOR level** following the FIG regulations.

Gymnasts must be at least **13 years old** (born in 2012 or before)

Qualifications: 1 balance and 1 tempo exercise

Finals: 1 combined exercise Scores in finals will start from 0

The number of units in Finals will be a % based on the number of units in qualifications : it will be defined after definitive registrations.

Draw of lots by acro companion (scoring system) will determine the starting order for qualifications and for finals.

Tie break rules according to FIG Technical Regulations section 5 art.1.4

Entry Fees are **50 € / gymnast**.

There will also be a team match based on difficulty level: **Diff ' Team Battle**

All details will be provided after Definitive registrations.

06. DEADLINES for ENTRIES

Definitive entry : **31st July 2025**

Nominative entry : **4th September 2025**

Delegations (Federations – Clubs) are responsible for their definitive and nominative entries through Acro Companion (<https://www.acro-companion.com/> Follow the guides)

07. ACCREDITATION - TARIFF SHEETS and MUSICS

The accreditation system identifies individuals participating in the competition and ensures controlled access to each area. All participants and officials are required to wear accreditation cards at all times.

At accreditation, The Head of Delegation must check the correct names of their complete delegation, verify accommodation requirements and make the necessary payments, including insurance if no certificate of insurance is uploaded.

Lost accreditation cards can be replaced at a price of 100€.

The Head of Delegation have to present the passports of all members of the team. In order to save time, we encourage delegations to upload copies of passports and insurance certificate as early as possible in the registration process in Acro Companion.

The definitive workplan will be given at the time of accreditation.

Tariff sheets must be made on Acro Companion software and uploaded until 22nd September 2025.

Music must be uploaded on Acro Companion software until 22nd September 2025.

The competition number of each unit will be automatically filled in on the received tariff sheets after the nominative entry by Acro Companion.

08. Pictures, Videos and Measurements of Gymnasts

On **Thursday 2nd October**, each unit must be taken in picture for the presentation during the qualifications and finals and must attend the measurement procedure.

There will be a live streaming of the entire competition and a TV broadcast of the finals.

09. MEDICAL SERVICE

Medical services during competition will be provided by a doctor and a team of the Red Cross.

Nearest General Hospital at 10 minutes' drive from venue.

10. ACCOMODATIONS' PACKAGE (**ALL IN**)

All participating delegations can book accommodation through the LOC via Acro Companion.

If they choose “No Package”, LOC will not provide meals, local transport and banquet.

Full board / banquet and local transport are included in the accommodation packages. Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Lunch and dinner will be served at the catering hall open (Tent near by the venue) presentation of the accreditation badge.

Transfers from and to Nice airport or Antibes railway station to and from the official hotels as well as between official hotels and the competition venue will be provided to the delegations. The local transport schedule will be communicated after nominative entries.

The prices are calculated with all meals from dinner on arrival day until breakfast on departure day.

11. FINANCES

The delegations are responsible for covering their travel expenses, accommodation, meals and entry fee.

100% of the entry fee + 50% of the accommodation package must be paid for **31st July 2025** (at the time of the definitive entry)

The total accommodation fee should be paid for **4th September 2025** (at the time of the nominative entry)

12. CANCELLATION POLICY

The entry fee is not refundable.

Accommodation Package:

Until 31st July 2025: Full reimbursement of the payment already done (if any)

1st August – 4th September 2025: 50% of the total accommodation package payment is due (no refund of the first payment)

From 5th September 2025: 100% of the total accommodation package payment is due (no refund of the first and second payment)

13. PRIZE MONEY

The prize money, free of any deductible taxes, will be distributed in euro as follows:

Pairs and Groups

- Gold : 300 € (per gymnast)
- Silver : 200 € (per gymnast)
- Bronze : 100 € (per gymnast)

In case of a tie, the prize money will be added and divided by the number of gymnasts (example: 1, 1, 3 the prize money for rank 1 and 2 is added and divided by 2)

14. INSURANCE

All delegations are responsible for having the necessary coverage against accidents and illness. Those certificates of insurance (copy of policy) can be uploaded via Acro Companion at definitive registration. All persons who cannot provide proof of adequate insurance coverage at time of accreditation are offered an insurance package at the cost of 62 €.

15. VISA

If you need an official invitation to obtain a visa to travel to France, you can request this by Acro Companion.
