

In Detail

Bus transfer

On Friday, some of you will be picked up at the airport in Salzburg.

Please look for this guy. Christian is your taxi driver.

The airport in Salzburg is quite small. But in case you don't find him, you can call +43 664 85 83 831.



On Sunday, the bus from Gmunden to the airport leaves at 16:00 from the Kirchenplatz. The location is added to the <u>map</u>. Don't worry! The drive to the airport is around one hour. And due to the size of the airport in Salzburg, you will have sufficient time before your flight.

Parking

If you are coming by car and you don't have parking at your hotel/apartment, you have several possibilities to park your car in Gmunden. But in general: all parking spots in the city center or close to the lake are with a fee from 9:00 to 17:00, every day, with an approx. max. fee of 8 €/day. Please make sure to look at the signs what the max. parking time is.

For audience, we suggest the parking "Seilergasse" or "Michlgründe". See <u>map</u>. The parking garage close to the theatre is nice in winter, but very narrow for today's cars.

Registration and ID-Check

This is the first time in an ERSO event, that everyone had to book their own accommodation and could choose, if they wanted to buy some of the offered meal options.

Therefore, we do not have one common meeting point or time for the registration and for doing the ID-check of the athletes.

"Magic lights" at the Grünberg



The tickets for those who have booked the "magic lights" are deposited at the cashier desk of the cable car valley station (see map). Just mention that you are from the European Show Contest, from which country you are and how many tickets you need.

Calculate around 35 minutes for the 2,5 km of the treetop walkway with the magic lights, depending on how often and how long you are stopping to take pictures.

Bring warm shoes and clothes to enjoy the magic lights at each weather. At the moment, the weather forecast predicts perfect weather for Friday evening © 0°C but mostly cloudless.

Meals

Thank you for having chosen your meals already in advance.

On Friday, at the Grünbergalm, the dinner is served. The waiters will ask you for your choice and serve accordingly. Don't miss the last ride back with the cable car at 20:30!

Lunch and Dinner on Saturday as well as Lunch on Sunday will be in buffet style. This means that you can also try a bit of the other things, but it is highly appreciated to stick with what you have chosen.





Christmas market

The Christmas market in Gmunden is open on all three days. Friday until 20:00, Saturday from 10:00 to 20:00 and Sunday as of 11:00.

Maybe of interest for supporters: On Saturday and Sunday, there are "christmassy" guided tours at 10:30. Meeting point: in front of the city hall (Rathaus).

In 2018, the Rope'n'Rollers found a home at the "UNION Gänserndorf" club, along with 11 other young athletes aged from 11 to 16 years.




If they are not jumping most of our boys love to play video games, but there aren't any featuring rope skipping.

Drinking coffee before training is our ritual.


