RULES FOR TRANSMISSION

The camera/computer/cell phone must be used in a **horizontal position**, at least 4-5 meters from the trampoline.

In all cases, transmission devices must be static (not moving).

5. EQUIPMENT

Participants with any equipment not complying with the following apparatus norms will not be allowed to compete.

SIDE VIEW	FRONT VIEW	TOP VIEW

Inground Trampolines will be allowed as long as you comply with the transmission indications. Gymnasts must compete under the supervision of a qualified instructor.

6. RULES

The event will be organized under the following rules:

Competition:

EACH CLUB WILL COMPETE IN THE SAME ROUND

- One (1) Round composed by three (3) voluntary routines (FREE DD). The two (2) total highest score of the three (3) routines will be taken for the final ranking.
- The starting order is decided by a draw. The rounds will be divided by clubs with no more than ten (10) gymnasts per group. Each group must perform their first, second and third routine prior to the next group starts.

Gymnasts will compete one after the other. The signal will only be given by the Organizing Committee.

When the round is finished, the video will be uploaded straight to Facebook to be evaluated by the judges.

- The winner will be the gymnast with the highest score (BEST TWO ROUTINES).



- Ties will not be broken.

Final result will be published in a maximum time of two (2) days after finishing the tournament (all rounds finished).

ROUTINES

- Each routine consists of ten (10) elements.
- Second attempts at exercises are not allowed.
- If a gymnast is obviously disturbed in a routine (faulty equipment or bad Wi-Fi connection), the Organizing Committee will consider if another attempt is allowed. A gymnast's clothing will not be classified as "equipment".

DRESS FOR GYMNASTS AND SPOTTERS

Male gymnasts

- Sleeveless or short sleeves leotard, gym shorts or gym trousers.
- White trampoline shoes and/or foot covering of the same colour as the gym trousers.

Female gymnasts

- Leotard or unitard with or without sleeves or long tights may be worn (must be skin-tight).
- Gym shorts may be worn (must be skin-tight).
- Trampoline shoes and/or white foot covering.
- The wearing of jewelry or watches is not permitted during the competition. Rings without gemstones may be worn if they are taped.

Coaches

- Track suit or shorts and T-shirt, and sport shoes.

COMPETITION CARDS

Will not be required.

SCORING

- Two (2) types of marks are used:

“D” mark, which is the total of the degree of difficulty in each routine.

“E” mark, which is the total given by an Execution Judge in each routine. In all routines, the highest and lowest execution score will be eliminated. The remaining scores (3) will be added to the difficulty to get the total score.

Method of scoring

- The evaluation of execution and difficulty is done in 1/10 of a point.
- Evaluation of the score for execution (E):
- Execution Judges make deductions for poor execution.



- The highest and lowest marks of the Execution Judges will be deleted and the three (3) remaining marks will be added together to give the gymnast's execution score for each routine (E+E+E).
- Evaluation of the score for difficulty (D):
- The Difficulty Judges calculate the difficulty of an exercise.
- Total score for an exercise:
- The total score is calculated by adding together "E" marks (execution) and "D" mark (difficulty) and deducting penalties. Score = E (max. 30 pts) + D - Penalty
- The Organizing Committee will be in charge of determining the validity of the final scores.
- Excel program will be used for recording scores.

WARMING UP

- Free starting (will not be transmitted).
- There will be no one touch before the competition.

START OF A ROUTINE

- Each gymnast will start on a signal given by the Organizing Committee.
- After the signal has been given, the gymnast must initiate the first element within one (1) minute, otherwise there will be a penalty from the Organizing Committee as follows:

EXCEEDING TIME	PENALTY
61 SECONDS	0.2 pts.
91 SECONDS	0.4 pts.
121 SECONDS	0.6 pts.
181 SECONDS	DNS*

- If there is a faulty start, the gymnast may re-start on a signal given by the Organizing Committee.
- * If the gymnast will not be allowed to start the routine, no score will be awarded and a designation of "Did Not Start (DNS)" will be given. If this time limit is exceeded because of faulty equipment or other substantial cause, no deduction will be applied.*

REPETITION OF ELEMENTS

- During a routine no element can be repeated, otherwise the difficulty of the repeated element will not be counted. Elements having the same amount of rotation but performed in the tucked, piked and straight positions are considered to be different elements and not repetitions.
- Multiple somersaults (630° or more) having the same number of twists and somersaults will not be considered a repetition if the twist is located in different phases. All multiple somersaults with the same amount of twisting rotation, performed without a recognizable pause in twisting rotation or without defined positions will be considered as repetitions in case they are used more than once.

7. INVITED CLUBS

Gymnasts with the correct age may take part in these 1° TRAMPOLINE HOPES CUP.

The maximum size of each delegation is free (10 PeR round).

12. DRAW

The gymnasts draw will decide the starting order of the competition. It will take place after the deadline of the nominative entry. The starting order will be published by the Organizing Committee in the Facebook page.

13. WORK PLAN

The work plan and the start list will be published in the Facebook page, one week before the start of the competition.

14. INSURANCE

The Organizing Committee will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents and the like. All participating clubs are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurances.

Participation is at own risk. GLOBAL GYMNASTICS CENTER & Dance Institute will not be responsible for accidents.

15. AWARDS

First place will receive a gold medal and one (1) leotard.

Second place will receive a silver medal and one (1) leotard.

Third place will receive a bronze medal and one (1) leotard.



16. FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS – PAYMENT

Payments:

The non-refundable registration fee of USD 25.- per gymnast must be paid to the Organizing Committee. Registrations without the appropriate payment of the registration fee at the time of the Nominative Registration will be considered invalid (i.e. the athletes will not be allowed to compete).

Each participating Club is kindly requested to clearly state payment as follows:


